Scripture

Let every skillful man among you come, and make all that the Lord has commanded: the tabernacle, its tent and its covering, its hooks and its boards, its bars, its pillars, and its sockets. **Exodus 35:10-11**

Summary

When God commanded Moses to make the tabernacle, He told Moses to hire the most gifted and skilled craftsmen in all of Israel.
